ABM has launched an appeal in support emergency relief efforts to assist the many Rohingya refugees fleeing from the increasingly violent situation in Myanmar. We are aiming to raise \$20,000 to provide vital medical care, emergency food, clean water, and hygiene and sanitation kits for the victims of this crisis.

VANUATU VOLCANO EMERGENCY

ABM is working closely with the Anglican Church of Melanesia in Vanuatu with an Emergency Appeal to assist victims of the Manaro Volcano eruptions on the island of Ambae in the north of the country. The situation is dire as the Vanuatu Government has ordered a full-scale evacuation of the island and \$10,000 is needed to ensure essential supplies of food and water are delivered to those in greatest need.

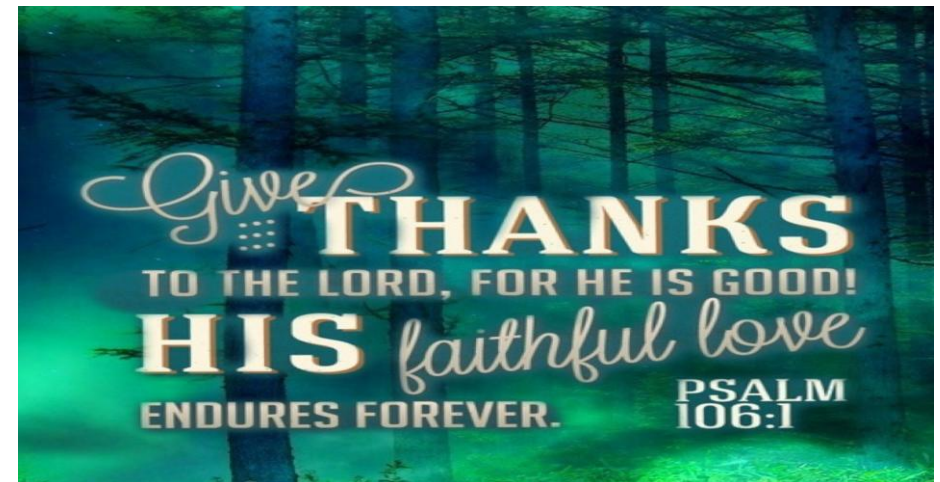
