#### **Lessons From the Parable of the Growing Seed:**

- Jesus' disciples are called to labor together to 1) learn the truth and 2) share it with others.
- But for all of our efforts, we are merely the messengers of the word, God is the one who gives the increase.
- The result of what His word does within a persons life:
  - May take some time (so be patient)
  - May depend on God "watering," that is doing things in His own time – working in their lives as He sees fit, when He sees fit and how He sees fit.
- The parable illustrates that the power is in the word of God, not man.

**THE NEW PARISH ELECTORAL ROLL**

**BEFORE:** Signing the Parish Roll you need to consider a number of significant statements beforehand. The Roll becomes a list of those who have declared their willingness to participate more fully in the life of their church by regular attendance at Services and in the giving of their time and talents within the church. During the last twelve months have attended Divine Services in the Parish on not less than six occasions, have reached the age of 16 years and are **a Baptised member of the Anglican Church of Australia** and are not on the Roll of any other Anglican Parish. The new Roll will remain valid for three years and reflects the active core of church supporters entitled to vote at church meetings.
