- Both Glebe Farms are looking well.
- The refurbishment of the Meeting Room at the Parish hall is well under way. The floor has been replaced. New carpet to be a traditional type broadloom with underlay. Touch-up painting still to be done.
- Mr. Aub. Morgan praised for his work in keeping the Longford cemetery in such good shape.
- The graveyard at Illawarra is having a tidy up as well.
- \$500 allocated for the purchase of a new dish washer at Rectory.
- A First-Aid kit to be purchased for the Parish Hall.
