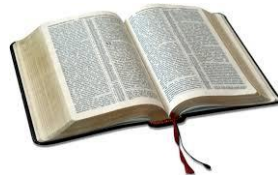

Roy Blair will be the speaker for the day. He has been breeding and showing budgerigars for 48 years and judging locally, interstate and overseas. First recorded in 1805, budgerigars are popular pets around the world due to their small size, low cost, and ability to mimic human speech. They are the third most popular pet in the world, after the domesticated dog and cat. They have been bred in captivity since the 19th century. Found wild throughout the drier parts of Australia, prior to colonisation they had survived harsh inland conditions for five million years. Roy will give an insight into his very interesting hobby and will bring along several different varieties and coloured birds to show.
